## WHAT TO BRING

**ELECTRONICS** (SSI) flat screen and tube TVs, monitors, computers, laptops, tablets, readers, keyboards, mice, printers, scanners, copiers, fax machines, VCRs, DVD/CD/tape players, stereos, radios, projectors, routers, modems, switches, electronic alarm clocks, cell phones, chargers, gaming consoles, electrical/computer cables, digital cameras, video cameras, MP3/music players, power supplies, digital converters, small scale servers

**SCRAP METAL** (Roy Strom): washers, dryers, radiators, metal lawn furniture, metal hangers, rusty swing sets, metal garbage cans, metal garden tools, water heaters, metal railings, metal pots and pans, gutters, metal shovels, metal shelving, metal wagons, metal pipes, metal wheel barrels, metal chicken wire, tomato cages, auto radiators, old & empty propane tanks

**HOUSEWARES** (Epilepsy Foundation) clothing, sheets, towels, blankets, shoes, purses, small household items (no prewired fixtures or fans - only working lamps or stand-alone fans. *Non-useable fabric material (single socks, torn sheets, etc) should be placed in a separate bag and labeled scrap fabric.*

**BATTERIES & LIGHT BULBS** (Roy Strom/Bulbs and Batteries): alkaline household batteries, button batteries, car/boat/sump pump batteries, CFLs and fluorescent tubes under 6 ft in length

**MISCELLANEOUS** (SCARCE/VFW/Sugar Beet Coop) musical instruments, Brita filters, corks, keys, tattered and torn American Flags for proper retirement, ink jet cartridges, CDs/DVDs removed from cases, LPs, sports equipment, holiday lights, unused greeting cards, yard signs

**SCHOOL SUPPLIES** (SCARCE): rulers, pencils, crayons, usable spiral notebooks, yarn, art supplies, rubber stamps, buttons, books

**WORKING BIKES** adult bikes in repairable condition, gently used kids' bikes, bike carriers/trailers with all parts/mounts included, bike parts and tools, helmets in good condition

**MEDICAL** (Lions Club and River Forest Police Dept.) eyeglasses, hearing aids, unwanted/unused/expired medications (prescription or OTC) for pets or humans

**NO LIQUIDS and NO SHARPS**

**PET SUPPLIES** (Animal Care League) collars, leashes, carriers, food bowls, blankets and old towels, pet medications

## DO NOT BRING

Hazardous materials or paint of any kind, mattresses, dehumidifiers, air conditioners, refrigerators, cribs, car seats, plastic playsets, plastic riding toys, wheelchairs or other medical equipment, shredded paper

*If we cannot reuse or recycle an item,  
you will be asked to take it back home for disposal.*
