Computer equipment: Monitors⁺, Computers (CPUs, Laptops, Tablets, computer batteries), Circuit Boards, Computer Drives & Hard Drives, Keyboards & Mice, Mainframes, Modems, Power Supplies, Docking Stations, Printers, Scanners, Small Scale Servers

Home entertainment: TVs⁺, DVD Players & Recorders, VCRs, Video Game Consoles, Cable Receivers, Satellite Receivers, Digital Converter Boxes, Projectors, Portable Digital Music Players, Stereos, Speakers (no large wood speakers), CD Players, Cameras

Communication equipment: Phones, Fax Machines, Cell Phones, PDA Organizers

Small appliances: Blenders, Fans (metal only), Coffee machines (no glass), Humidifiers, Microwaves, Toasters, Vacuums (remove cloth bags)

Misc: Adaptors, Ballasts, Wires & cables, Christmas lights, Holiday light strings, Extension cords & power strips

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED

DVDs, Video and audio cassettes, large home appliances/white goods (stoves, washing machines, refrigerators, freezers), air conditioners, large stereo speakers (extra-large wooden-box speakers), batteries.

Hazardous waste, Mercury-containing devices, thermostats, thermometers, smoke detectors, liquids and gases, fluorescent tubes and lightbulbs.
