ACCEPTED RECYCLING ITEMS

Electronics Accepted items: computers, laptops, servers, computer monitors, televisions, printers, facsimile, scanners, VCR & DVD players, video game consoles, cell phones along with other electronics and small household appliances as specified on this full list. Appliances with refrigerants and all other items not listed cannot be accepted.

Retired US official Flags: Torn, tattered, faded US official flags for retirement services by VFW Post 2377 as part of a Village program spearheaded by Trustee Chester Pojack in 2004 to respectfully retire US Flags.

Textiles: Any gently used clothing, shoes (must be matched and tied together), sheets, bedding, towels and other household textiles in any condition. No heavily soiled items. Items must be bagged. Textiles will be collected by ReWearable.

Miscellaneous Items: Hardcover, paperback, children's and textbooks; Brita Filters and Pitchers; records - vinyl, 45's, LP; CDs - commercially made; DVDs - commercially made; musical instruments; crayons - whole and broken; bread tags, and keys. For questions, please call SCARCE 630.545.9710.

Broken Holiday Lights: All color and lengths of mini-lights (Italian Lights), C7, C9, rope lights, LED lights, extension cords sponsored by Elgin Recycling.

Household Batteries: Alkaline, carbon zinc, nickel iron, nickel metal hydride, nickel cadmium, zinc air.

Other Batteries: Car, boat and sump pump batteries.

Cell Phones for Re-Use Program: Cell phones and accessories, if possible.

Medical Equipment for Re-Use Program: Gently used metal crutches, wheelchairs, walkers and canes.

Glasses/Hearing Aids: Prescription and reading glasses, sunglasses, plastic frames and metal frames, and hearing aids to be donated to the Lions Club for reuse programs.
